EEDDALE THE TWEEDDALE SOCIETY

The first of the 6 monthly talks in the Tweeddale Society's 2025-26 programme will be given by Linda Haldane on Tuesday 14 th October. She will speak about the history of Manor Kirk. After volunteering to produce an exhibition to celebrate Manor Kirk's 150th anniversary in 2024, Linda spent many months researching the Kirk's history and the people who have been central to its story.

The resulting exhibition was a triumph, but Linda could not showcase all the interesting facts, photographs and anecdotes she had discovered. Linda will share these with us in her talk., which will take us through the ups and downs in Manor Kirk's history, from the laying of the foundation stone and the celebrations of the church's opening in 1874, through the war years and financial difficulties of the 1970s, to the refurbishment of the Kirk in the 1980s and the present day concerns for the building and its future.

Linda was brought up in Coldstream and studied accountancy and computer science at Heriot Watt University before going on to qualify as a Chartered Accountant. Now semi-retired Linda enjoys beekeeping and hill walking, and with her husband manages a small herd of Cheviot Mule sheep on their small holding in the Manor Valley.

The talk will be given in the Eastgate Theare auditorium at 7.30 pm. Membership of the Tweeddale Society (annual subscription £30) includes admission to all 6 talks. Peebles & District Community Council

Live Borders (LB) continues to concern many people in Peebles and across the Borders and your community council still engage with Scottish Borders Council (SBC) over it. A recent exchange highlighted to us the difficult and complex tasks they, SBC have to face and the lack of resource that they have to manage with. I would not disagree with any of this and indeed some of what SBC do, they do very well indeed. However, in my view and that of many of my contacts, LB is more a self-inflicted injury than an accident of circumstance, and SBC appear to be doing all they can to avoid acknowledgement of this. SBC say that the situation is urgent. It is, it was urgent in 2023 when "the serious position that the trust faces with the current setup being critically unsustainable" was noted. It was urgent when the March 2024 accounts were filed and identified that the base management fee provided by SBC was inadequate - Little if anything was done. It should have been clear to anyone who cared to look, that LB could not survive the level of cuts that they had had forced upon them, circa double those initiated by other local authorities with similar problems. If SBC were a commercial entity, shareholders would be holding directors to account. Public money should be managed just as efficiently, and should we, the rate payer, expect anything less?

Government, whether central or local is required to provide the services, that we as individuals are unable to provide for ourselves and that cannot be provided as commercial services. The law requires that a local authority ensures that there is adequate provision of facilities for recreational, sporting, cultural and social activities.

The Leader of the Council, Councillor Euan Jardine appears to agree with this requirement, at least where sport is concerned. To quote him from his recent article in the Herald: "Sport and physical activity are not luxuries", We need to invest more directly in sports clubs", "we should be removing barriers, not creating more of them", and "If many Scots value sport, why are we making it more difficult to access"? Why indeed! Perhaps the Leader of the Council should study our research and take this up internally.

Peebles and District Community Council has shared our Peebles Life and Peeblesshire News articles with SBC: the reaction shows a level of discomfort and a repetition of the same tired arguments; we're not to blame, it was Live Borders, it was Covid, it's urgent [why now, why not earlier?]. However, to repeat, SBC's own commissioned report includes a serious indictment! "a lack of strong leadership and governance, the absence of a senior leadership team, unclear strategic direction, limited accountability, weak oversight of financial and operational performance, poor data utilisation, lack of performance driven culture, Inefficient resource allocation and suboptimal service planning. Surely, it did not take a consultant to identify this. Where was the SBC oversight? Perhaps no one was responsible, that is the modern way isn't it! However, to end, last week I met the new Chief Executive of Live Borders. Time will tell how well she succeeds in her task. It will not be easy. However, without adequate support from SBC, her task will be impossible.

This month's speaker is **Dr Sam Leggett**, an Edinburgh University lecturer specialising in biomolecular archaeology and the Middle Ages. Before moving to Edinburgh in 2022 she

was an Oxford University researcher undertaking biomolecular work for Time Team and commercial units including on the Anglo-Saxon bed burial at Trumpington in Cambridgeshire.

With the intriguing title 'The Salmon of Knowledge? Identity, mobility and food in medieval Scotland', she will be telling us about ArchaeoFINS, a Leverhulme Trust funded project looking at the medieval archaeology of fishing in the Irish and North Seas. ArchaeoFINS is centred around an old and still unresolved

archaeological question of when,

why and where people began to eat fish again after the introduction of farming to Europe, which brought about a decline in fish consumption c. 5-10,000 years ago in favour of cereal crops and dairying.

Sam is investigating the "Fish Event Horizon", using Scotland, a watershed region for the re-introduction of fish consumption in western Europe in the

Middle Ages, as the core study area. So far 500 samples have been analysed from five Scottish sites: Upper Scalloway in Shetland, Iona, Finlaggan on Islay, Gairloch Wester Ross, and Castle Park, Dunbar. Isotopic data from humans, plants and animals reveal what they were eating and where they may have migrated from/to; as well as organic residues from pottery that show what was being cooked/processed/stored in a variety of vessels at these sites.

Sam has uncovered possible dietary taboos and the "missing" dead, human mobility and imported dietary practices, surprising culinary practices in the pots, and complex ecological relationships in coastal and island environments. The re-adoption of marine fish into medieval diets is not a straightforward process even for islanders and coastal dwellers.





As the season ends the club AGM has been confirmed for Monday 27th of October at the Drill Hall, all members are encouraged to attend.



Gardening Tips from Woodside

Autumn is now upon us and the bright colours of the summer garden are fading, and it's time to turn our attention to winter and all year round interest plants.

Conifers often suffer from bad press, but they really are fantastic plants which allow you to enjoy colour and structure in the garden 365 days of the year, and the best part of all is that they are so easy to grow it hardly takes any effort!

The foliage of conifers is surprisingly varied in colour with shades of blue/grey, green, orange, yellow and variegated foliage all adding character to your garden. They also come in different shapes for different garden situations – prostrate for groundcover, columns and cones for accent points, bushy for screening and gap filling, and ball shapes for feature planting. And of course there are hedging varieties too. A bit of pruning is sometimes required to keep the shape you need, but always try and work with the natural shape to get the best results.

Columnar conifers benefit from being bound with twine over the winter to prevent the wind and snow distorting the shape, but done well this is hardly visible.

People often worry about the height of conifers, so it's important to choose the growth rate that fits your needs. Take time to read the label and it will give you an indication of the annual growth rate. They vary from very slow (1-3cm per year) which are conifers suitable for alpine troughs, rockeries and container, to very fast (25-30cm per year) which make excellent screening plants, and all the growth rates in between. Don't forget that conifers keep growing, so don't be caught out by the labels stating the height after 10 years.

Conifers, when planted in a garden and mixed with other plants, provide a haven for wildlife. Birds appreciate the shelter for roosting all year round, and many will also nest in conifers, insects will pupate in the bark, and spiders find them the perfect habitat for their webs. Conifers also help the planet by absorbing carbon dioxide from the atmosphere and storing it as carbon for many years. With conifers in many gardens the in the UK the benefit soon accumulates, so even by planting one conifer you are helping to make a difference.

My favourites include Picea glauca Sanders Blue – a slow growing dwarf Spruce in a neat cone shape with blue tinged needles, Thuja plicata Whipcord – a bizarre mound forming conifer with dreadlock like foliage, Tsuga Coles Prostrate – a beautiful ground covering plant with dense carpets of foliage, and Cupressus Wilma – a cheerful yellow foliage upright conifer, great for planting in containers and surrounding with pansies or violas for autumn and winter impact.

As you can tell, I'm a big fan of conifers when planted in the right place, as they are so varied in character and so easy to grow. They associate well with other shrubs such as Pieris and Physocarpus, and they can be underplanted with heathers for a traditional look, or with a wide range of perennial plants for a softer appearance. They are also very useful in pots as you can use them as the centrepiece all year round and add bedding plants throughout the year for seasonal interest.

Plant with a good compost – I recommend Growmoor Multi-purpose Compost with added John Innes, and plenty of Rootgrow for a head start and top off with composted bark for a tidy finish and to help improve soil structure. Don't forget to feed each growing season with fertiliser to keep them looking fresh and healthy so that you have many years of enjoyment season after season.



Peebles Gutterbluids Society Update

At our last Committee meeting, members were pleased to learn that three new volunteers, who had contributed to our various outdoor work activities with enthusiasm over a period, had applied to join our Society. Committee members were agreeable, and their membership was approved. It was reported that 'The Old Town Story' information notice board had been received, and is now displayed on the main wall of the Old Town Garden.

Reports were recorded on several of our annual activities, including the refurbishment of a bench seat at Dovecot Court Inner Garden, plus the repainting of the garden statues. A further bench had been refurbished and was sited at the Dovecot Court Outer Garden. Various benches at different locations had weed / grass control done, including picnic bench at Lyne Station Ford; milestones and bench along the B7062 road to Cardrona; plus benches painted at Dovecot Community Garden, and by the Cuddy riverside.

Metal clothes poles were refurbished and repainted at the Communal drying areas at Tweed Green and Greenside. A member plus two other volunteers rebuilt a damaged retaining dry-stane dyke on the Venlaw Right of Way, near South Lodge. Three other volunteers along with a member cut back invasive weed and shrub growth at the South Lodge driveway and the lower Venlaw paths.

These are just a selection of the many and varied tasks, annual and new, undertaken by both Gutterbluids members and other volunteers, to tidy up and enhance many areas in Peebles and surrounding areas.
